Qualification Aims and Format

This Award develops leadership and management skills alongside specific FM competences, and lays the foundation for further formal development in this role.

There are four key elements to the Qualification being delivered through BIFM Training: attendance at the 3 day BIFM flagship training programme "Understanding FM"; on-line learning courses; work based assignments and some further reading. These elements provide a thorough grounding in FM skills and knowledge – the 3 day training programme alone has a long established track record within the profession. It is possible to complete the qualification within 6 months.
